Covid Guidelines

With all legal restrictions now lifted, we are delighted that our Sailing Programme can go ahead. However, we remain very mindful of the need to protect the safety of all involved. We have implemented a number of measures for the Yacht Series to allow those who do not wish to visit the clubs in person to participate:

- We have dropped the usual requirement to register at RDYC – Sailing Instructions will be available as a downloadable pdf from the 21st August, although a printed booklet will also be available to collect if preferred.
- The Skippers' Briefing and the Prizegiving can be attended via Zoom.
- The Official Noticeboard and the Results will be available online.
- Protests and Scoring Enquiries can be submitted via a mobile phone app (details coming soon).

We respectfully ask all competitors and visitors to follow these guidelines:

- Please take a lateral flow test before travelling to the Regatta or visiting the clubs during Regatta Week. This is not a mandatory requirement because it would be impossible to enforce, but will give peace of mind to our other participants, volunteers, race officials, staff and club members. Kits can be obtained free-of-charge, see www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests.
- Do not attend the Regatta if you have relevant symptoms, have tested positive, or have been told officially to self-isolate.
- Skippers should be mindful of the safety of their crew members when on-board.
- When visiting the clubs, please exercise personal responsibility and show consideration for others. Remember they may have concerns or vulnerabilities that you are not aware of.
 - Use the hand sanitiser provided, or wash your hands regularly.
 - Where practical, maintain social distance from those not in your own crew or social group.
 - Wear a face mask when moving between areas in the Clubhouses, in confined spaces, or when social distancing is not possible.
 - Comply with any room limits on numbers of people, and follow any one-way systems. Avoid obstructing corridors or walkways.
