Senior Dinghy Racing will be based at Dittisham Sailing Club (DSC)

Club Facilities, Food & Drink

Showers, light snacks, sandwiches and beverages will be available each day at the DSC clubhouse located on the beach adjacent to the dinghy park. Light refreshments for competitors at the end of each day's racing are included in the entry fee.

Accommodation.

Dinghy & Car Parking

It is worth noting that car parks in Dittisham are linked to the (free to download) RingGo cashless parking mobile phone App, as are several other car parks in Dartmouth and Kingswear. SENIOR DINGHY JOINING NOTES

If you plan to arrive with your boat on **Friday 21st** it is **ESSENTIAL** that you **contact the Boat Park Officer**, boatpark@dittishamsc.org.uk, in advance, and she will tell you where to put your boat.

To find the Club get onto the A381 Totnes to Kingsbridge road and at Halwell take the turnoff to Dartmouth onto the A3122.

After a little over three miles the A3122 takes a sharp bend to the right at the Sportsman's Arms public house. Leave it at this point by bearing left (almost straight on) signposted Dittisham. After another three miles you enter the village at a 'T' junction. Ahead you will see the Red Lion pub, bear left here and immediately right into Riverside Road. Approx 200 yards down Riverside Road you will see on the right a sign to 'The Ham' car park. Go down into the car park and straight through it down the ramp to the foreshore. Bear left along the foreshore and drive on until you see the Clubhouse.

Leave your boat and trolley here and park your car and trailer as directed by the Beachmaster, who will be on duty **from 08:00 on Saturday 22nd August** to welcome you and sign you in. If you arrive prior to this, please temporarily park in The Ham car park.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO GET TO DITTISHAM BY ANY OTHER ROAD ROUTE ESPECIALLY IF YOU ARE TOWING A BOAT!

The Ham car park is quite small but has reasonable charges. Trailers can be parked on the Ham itself free of charge but only in designated spots. If the car park is full then use Riverside Road, which is free, but 200 yards away.

Cars and trailers are only allowed on the foreshore to unload dinghies and trolleys.
