Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sailing Week - April update

Thank you to all those who have already registered for this year's events. There has been interest across the board, particularly for the IRC (full rig) class, and we are looking forward to welcoming both newcomers and regulars! As mentioned in a previous email, our aim is to offer as much flexibility as possible in this year of uncertainty – so as well as full rig classes we will have non-spinnaker options for both IRC and Cruisers yachts, to suit those who may prefer to sail with family-only crews, or be unable to muster the full crew numbers. Advance registration is now open, with no initial fee and no commitment, and with change of class available until 14th August.

A reminder that the Senior Dinghy Series will take place ahead of the main regatta week due to tidal constraints at Dittisham – with no clash of dates, perhaps this is an opportunity for those who have moved on to yacht racing to arrange use of a club dinghy, and for the more experienced juniors to try their hand in senior competition as well.

The Port of Dartmouth Royal Regatta committee are busy putting plans in place for events in town, whilst continuing to monitor the COVID situation closely. As well as the rowing and other sporting events, live music and fireworks are in the pipeline so there should be plenty of entertainment and social activity to look forward to. For those able to be in Dartmouth earlier in the year, there are two other events that may be of interest. Over the Spring Bank Holiday, RDYC will be hosting a 2-day May regatta with IRC, SW YTC and Day Boat classes. Clubs represented by teams of 3 boats will also vie for the Commodore's Cup. Full details and entry forms are available from the RDYC website. And at the start of July, classic yachts will be competing in the first 2 days of the Classic Channel Regatta, with a Parade of Sail giving spectators on the Embankment a fine view of these lovely craft.
